- Bring your fully charged mobile devices (laptops, tablets, mobile phones) and your necessary log-in passwords.
- If you have not registered yet, think of your unique FrontSteps Password in advance. Write it down and bring it with you to the training. FrontSteps passwords must be at least 6 characters and contain a number, a lower-case letter, an upper-case letter, and a non-alphanumeric character. You will get one-on-one help during the session.
- If you're unsure what email address the Administration Office has for you, please call them at 805-484-2861 prior to July 25. You may have to visit the office to fill out a new AIF (Association Information Form). The training session will be televised live on LVTv, Channel 1390, and rebroadcast on future dates.
